CAMPUS: The main building is located in the former headquarters of the Norfolk and Western Railroad in the heart of downtown Roanoke.

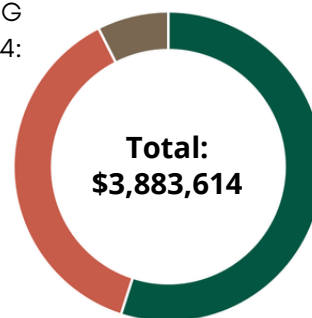
Across from the main building, the Claude Moore Education Complex opened in 2007 to house Virginia Western Community College's culinary arts degree program.
