

SUBMIT A REQUEST

On the Interlibrary Loan page, look for the orange **Submit a Request** button.

If it's your first time making a request you'll need to make an account. Click **Create an Account** on the sign-in page. You will need to provide your RHEC Library Card barcode number, which is the number on the back of your card.
